



# Policy/Rules and Regulations

## Domaine du Lac Libby

ENR. 200023 (Camping Québec)

To ensure you have a pleasant stay, please read the following rules and abide by them.

### POLICY

#### Campers and visitors

- A group of campers includes 2 adults and 4 minor children.
- One equipment per site (including tents).
- A maximum number of four adults is allowed on the same site, including visitors.
- Campers are responsible for the proper conduct of their guests on the site.
- Visitors must register and pay entry fees. Daily visitors need to leave the Domaine before 10 p.m.
- No visitor can enter the site after 9 p.m.

#### Check-in/check-out time

- Check-in at the Domaine is possible as soon as 1 p.m. and up to 9 p.m.
- The check-out time is also scheduled for 1 p.m.
- There is no reimbursement in case of early check-out.

#### Reservations cancellation and reimbursement

- All site reservations are guaranteed up to 1 p.m. the day after the reserved check-in date. If campers do not show up before noon, the day after their expected check-in day, the Domaine reserves the right to rent the site to another party without prior notice. No cashback or reimbursement will be made for any reason whatsoever.
- All reservations are non-refundable and non-transferable.

#### WI-FI + Electric Charging Station

- Wi-Fi service is available on most sites.
- An electric vehicle charging station (Circuit électrique du Québec) is available near the leaching field. **Electricity at campsites** must be used for camping equipment only.

#### Recreational or Medical Cannabis

Domaine du Lac Libby Campground is known for its family-friendly atmosphere and the peacefulness of the site. To respect everyone's rights—especially children's right to a smoke-free and drug-free environment—management has adopted the following policy:

1. The use of any drugs in any form, including smoking and vaping, is prohibited throughout the entire campground.
2. Smoking cannabis is prohibited in all common areas within the campground (trails, wooded areas, playgrounds, beach, restrooms, picnic areas, shelters, etc.).
3. This prohibition on drug use and cannabis smoking also applies to your rented site.
4. However, limited use of recreational or medical cannabis is tolerated inside your camping unit only. You must ensure that odors are not detectable from neighboring sites or the roadway. If odors are noticeable, use is not permitted.
5. The cultivation and sale of cannabis are strictly prohibited anywhere on the campground.

Failure to comply with these rules may result in a verbal or written warning for a first offense. Repeat offenses may lead to eviction from the campground without refund.

### RULES AND REGULATIONS

#### Pets

- **Must be kept on a leash and under supervision at all times;** waste must be picked up; pets must not disturb other campers.
- Must not be left unattended in your equipment or on the site.
- **Not permitted near the beach**, in the rustic camping section, or in common areas (playground, showers, etc.).
- Breeds considered dangerous or aggressive by management are not permitted (such as: German Shepherd, Rottweiler, Doberman, Pit Bull, Mastiff, Bull Terrier, American Pit Bull, American Staffordshire Terrier, Great Dane, etc.).
- **Limit of one dog per owner, per site.** Dogs must be walked on a leash and with a waste bag.
- Guests' dogs are not permitted on the site.
- **Do not feed birds or small animals.** Some may become aggressive. To help reduce lake pollution, special attention is given to geese, ducks, etc.

#### Trees and shrubs

- No cutting, pruning, trimming, planting nails or damaging trees or shrubs on site.
- Dead wood must remain in place to ensure proper balance of the natural surroundings.
- Trees cannot serve as clothes lines or swings. No ties are allowed on trees.

# Policy/Rules and Regulations

## Domaine du Lac Libby

### Access gates, lighting system, speed limit and authorized vehicles

- Access gates to the site are closed from midnight to 8 a.m.
- **The speed limit is 8 km throughout the site** to protect children and pedestrians.
- Driving a motorcycle is forbidden, except for travellers who go directly to their site without making any noise (access is forbidden after 9 p.m.).
- Vehicles must be parked in the designated area (no parking on grass, along streets or unoccupied sites).
- Visitors' motorcycles must stay at the Domaine's entrance.
- Truck trailers must remain in the designated area in the parking lot during your stay.
- Bikes and children's bicycles must be put away at dusk.
- All electric equipment (such as electric scooters, etc.) or noisy equipment of the generator type, ATV, golf cart, etc., are forbidden on the Domaine's site.
- An electric cart could be allowed under the only condition that the user's mobility is impaired. Confirmation from the Domaine's head office is required before making a reservation.
- No lighting system is allowed.

### Curfew, campfire and noise

- Excessive noise is not tolerated. No noise is permitted after 11:00 p.m.
- Music at campsites **is permitted until 10:30 p.m.** and must not disturb neighbors. Loud music in vehicles is not allowed.
- Campfires may remain lit, and quiet conversations are permitted until 11:30 p.m.
- **Curfew is from 11:30 p.m. to 8:00 a.m. During this period, no outdoor activity is allowed.** If management must intervene a second time to enforce curfew, immediate eviction may occur without further notice.
- Campfires must be kept in designated fire pits and **extinguished no later than 11:30 p.m. Electric heaters, fire pits, and patio heaters are prohibited.**
- Moving fire rings is not permitted. Fires must be extinguished when left unattended. Burning hazardous materials, including plastics, is strictly prohibited.
- Fireworks, firecrackers, or any other pyrotechnic devices are prohibited on the property, even on holiday.

### Drinking water and maintenance of premises

- Using drinking water for excessive consumption is forbidden to avoid wasting water. It is also forbidden to wash vehicles, RVs, etc.
- We suggest that you let the water run for a few minutes when you get to the site.
- Campers must pay to use showers and the rates are as follows: 25¢ for each period of 3-4 minutes.
- **Caution with regards to grey and black waters:** no discharge is allowed on the site. Campers need to clean these water tanks, including those of portable toilets at the dumping station on Vison Street.
- In order to keep the site clean and in good condition at all times, garbage and recycling bags must be dropped in the containers close to the Domaine's exit.

### Beach, Swimming and Watercraft

- **Beach:** Supervised depending on conditions and attendance. **Children under 14 must be accompanied by an adult.** Glass containers are not permitted on the beach.
- Sound systems (radios, etc.) are not allowed.
- Smoking is prohibited on the beach and in all public areas of the property (in accordance with applicable laws).
- **Only watercraft** (boats, kayaks, paddleboards, oars, etc.) **belonging to seasonal campers and travelers are permitted** on-site to protect water quality and the lake environment. **Guests' watercraft are not allowed.** In accordance with the Lac Libby Association rules, **all watercraft must be washed with soap at the washing station at the entrance.** This measure helps prevent the spread of invasive species and avoid significant fines.

### Dumping

- The Domaine provides one designated dumping station. Use of a hose ring is required.

### IMPORTANT NOTICE

The immediate eviction measure without any possibility of reimbursement is applicable in the case where a person or group of individuals does not abide by these effective rules and regulations.

***Under no circumstances can the landlord be responsible for physical, psychological or material damages caused by the tenants' actions or any other incident that could occur to any individual on the campground as well as any partial or total power outage, running out of water, trees or electrical equipment falling down, due to atmospheric or weather conditions, by trees falling or any other situation, etc.***
